

Linking of highway corridors to international trade points

It is proposed to develop 1,911 km of International Connectivity Roads and 3319 kms of Border roads under the Bharatmala Pariyojana. In its first phase, it is proposed to develop 2,000 km of Border and International Connectivity Roads with an outlay of Rs 25,000 crore over a period of five years i.e. from 2017-18 to 2021-22 in the phased manner.

This information was given by the Minister of State for Road Transport and Highways Shri Mansukhlal Mandavi in a written reply to a question in Rajya Sabha today.
