The progress of Qazigund- Banihal tunnel project onNH-44 undertaken by National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) is 75.24% against the fund allocated amounting to Rs 2,648 crore for the project and scheduled to be completed by July, 2020.

The work of preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) costing Rs 3.23 crore for two laning of Mughal Road connecting Shopian to Baffliaz (in Punch District)including Mughal Road is in progress and scheduled to be completed by Jan, 2020. This state road is approved as "In-Principle" NH subject to outcome of DPR.
