

Beach Cleaning Drive Conducted by V.O. Chidambaranar Port

V.O. Chidambaranar Port Trust, as a part of achieving the biggest ever efforts towards achieving universal sanitation coverage, improving cleanliness and eliminating open defecation in the country, conducted a beach cleaning programme at the Port beach on 28.03.2017 with the support of around 200 students from Kamaraj College, Tuticorin.
